

Homework

During this half term we will be learning about:

English

The book that we will be concentrating our learning on this term will be 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. We will be discussing the text, making predictions, sequencing events, writing labels and our own story.

Plants:

- To identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.
- To identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

ICT

Our topic this half term is Bee-Bots. Within this topic we will be learning how to construct algorithms through programming the Bee-Bots with instructions to meet a specific goal. We will also have the opportunity to design our own Bee-Bot board.

Music

Our topic this half term is called 'Hey You!' which is an old-school Hip Hop style song where we will learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.

PE

We will be focusing on our fundamental movement skills in particular looking at the skill of running, developing the correct technique and applying this to a range of sporting activities. We will also be focusing on Gymnastics in particular Wide, Narrow and Curled balances and performing this as part of a routine.

RE

We will be looking Christianity and expressions of belonging and introducing the Bible through characters and stories.
