School Meals and Packed Lunches

Having a healthy diet and having the right nutrients can help a child's mood, their health and their ability to concentrate in lessons. School meals are freshly-cooked and exceed national standards for school lunches. Primary School menus are carefully developed to appeal to children and provide the perfect balance of essential nutrients - and to offer them the chance to try a few dishes they may not have tried before.

Children can choose from two main meal options provided every day, each one accompanied by a vegetable choice, and including a daily vegetarian dish. Jacket potatoes with an assortment of popular and tasty fillings are always available, too, served with an attractive side salad.

If your child prefers a packed lunch, then we encourage parents to provide a healthy packed lunch. Items such as fizzy pop and chocolate bars should not be sent in packed lunches.
